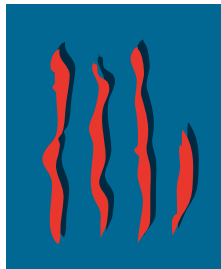


# The Company that Cried Padzilla

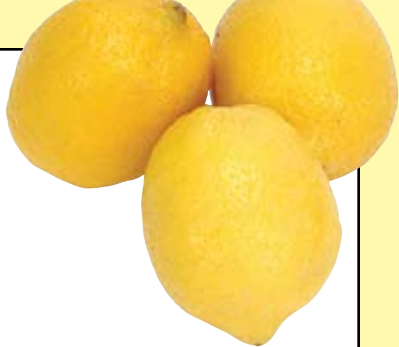

## Lemons into Lemonade

You may recall that commencing January 1, 2007, the Court system permitted us full access to all FED/eviction records. Since then, Tenant-Net has hired 7 field staff, spread across central and southern Maine, who regularly visit 19 of Maine's District Courts to collect eviction records.

Though there has been substantial inconvenience due to the Courts actions, the end result is we actually log records into our system much more quickly. This means more data is available each time you send us an inquiry.

We are also presently working with the Courts to recover and database as fast as possible those records previously denied running from June 2006 through to January 2007. We intend to close that the gap as rapidly as possible.
